Since 2005, CFFS has grown to become the largest film festival on the West Coast dedicated to children and their families, with an annual lineup piled high with shorts, features, and hands-on activities for all ages.



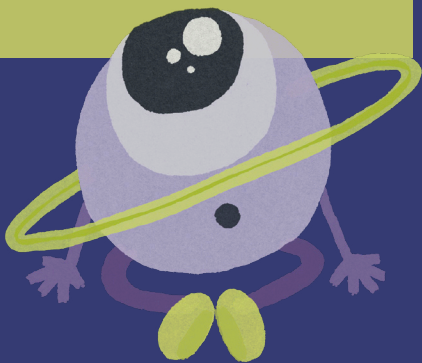

FILMS!

Each year, we showcase feature-length and short films from around the world including Argentina, France, Hungary, India, Japan, Korea, Latvia, Nicaragua, and Taiwan (to name a few). CFFS prioritizes stories that have been underrepresented in mainstream media and we curate film programs designed for every age, from tots to teens and everyone in between!



NATIONAL TOURING PROGRAM

Our touring "Best of Fest" program reaches thousands of families worldwide and plays in over 20 venues across the globe, including the ANDKIDS World Film Festival at Notre Dame University and the Hellenic American Union in Athens, Greece.

MULTILINGUAL PROGRAMS

Reflecting Seattle's multi-ethnic community, CFFS presents language-specific short film programs, to serve native speakers, educate new language learners, or spark curiosity. Each year, we host a program or two that are each entirely in one language, such as Spanish, German, French, and Japanese.

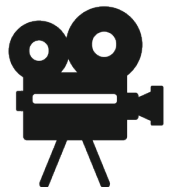


FIELD TRIPS

CFFS welcomes school field trip groups, now both virtually and in-person, with sliding scale ticketing based on financial need. Each screening includes activity packets and thought-provoking discussions to unpack complex themes and encourage social-emotional learning, empathy and media literacy.

WORKSHOPS

CFFS offers hands-on workshops on a variety of topics that complement each year's programming. Workshop tuition is priced on a sliding scale to meet families where they are financially. They are open to all ages, and led by experienced local filmmakers and artists.



YOUTH JURIES

Each year, more than 30 kids ages 8 -18 participate on diverse youth-led juries to determine official festival award winners! The process gives young film lovers an excellent opportunity to sharpen their critical eye and highlight issues of importance.
